# TERMS & CONDITION



1. The participants profile will be sent to the host organization in USA for Invitation
2. Once the profile is approved, the participant has to pay the advance fee of Rs 1 Lakh to register for the program, get the invitation and apply for the visa.
3. For Visa Assistance, you can go with your own travel agent or we can provide you contact details of our Travel Partner as well.
  - In case of Visa rejection, INR 10,000 will be deducted before initiating refund.
  - In case of Visa rejection due to furnishing inadequate/wrong documents (financial documents/other regulatory documents) , INR 25,000 will be deducted before initiating refund.
  - After the Visa Approval, if the Participant wishes to withdraw his/her participation, NO FEE WILL BE REFUNDED. The participant can request to carry forward the amount for some other program, final decision rests with the company.
4. Seats will be confirmed on the first come, first serve basis. (Seat will be confirmed after the Visa Approval and Payment of Full Program Fees)
5. Hotel accommodation is subject to availability. (If one Hotel is full, accommodation will be shifted to another nearby hotel)
6. The balance payment has to be made within 1 Week on Visa Approval.
7. The schedule given is tentative and detailed itinerary, Hotels, Timings, Venue , etc will be provided 15 days prior to travel.

- For Cancellation upto 30 days prior to the commencement of the event, 50% of the total program fees will be refunded.
